

## Certificate of Compliance

### **Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) Registration,**

The new European Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) Directive came into force on June 1, 2007 in the form of EC Regulation (No. 1907/ 2006). This statement clarifies Magnet-Schultz of America, Inc's position regarding the applicability of this legislation to our products.

**Magnet-Schultz of America (MSA) understands that there are currently no REACH requirements that apply to our products.**

Magnet-Schultz of America, Inc's solenoid products are defined as "Articles" under the REACH regulations Article 3(3). There is no known or intended release of chemical substances from MSA products under normal or foreseeable conditions.

With regard to the candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) published by the European Chemicals Agency, **Magnet-Schultz of America, Inc. does not use any of the current 155 SVHC candidate substances<sup>1</sup> in the manufacture of our products.**

For these reasons, the registration requirements defined in Article 7 of the REACH regulations and the notification requirements described in Article 33 do not apply to products manufactured by Magnet-Schultz of America, Inc.

Magnet-Schultz of America, Inc. is committed to maintaining the highest standards of environmental stewardship. This legislation will be monitored to ensure continued compliance.
