Job Summary

The Maintenance Technician is responsible for troubleshooting, repairing, and preforming preventive maintenance of machines, equipment, building and grounds including PLC's, robotics, mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, hydraulic, HVAC, and conveyor systems.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Respond to emergency calls for maintenance
- Diagnose and resolve mechanical, electrical, and pneumatic problems
- Plan and perform maintenance of machinery and equipment
- Document and report daily activities within maintenance logs
- Assist in assembly and installation of equipment and systems, (electrical, pneumatic and hydraulic)
- Maintain spare parts inventory
- Make recommendations for efficiency improvements
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Ability to read operations manuals, electrical, pneumatic and hydraulic schematics, mechanical drawings and work instructions.
- Ability to work in elevated areas requiring ladders or lifts
- Ability to operate scissor lift, power tools, and fork truck
- Strong problem solving and excellent communication skills
- Working knowledge of electrical (120V, 230V, and 480V), pneumatic, and hydraulic controls and systems.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to sit and stand for long periods of time
- Must be able to occasionally climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, and/or crawl
- Must be able to work more than 40 hours in a week and weekends when required
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds
