

## Certificate of Proposition 65 and PBT

Date: September 13, 2021

Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) is a Californian law that requires businesses to notify Californians about significant chemicals that cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. The law requires that no person doing business, knowingly and intentionally expose an individual to a chemical known to the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive toxicity without first giving a clear and reasonable warning.

Based on a thorough internal review it has been determined that Magnet Schultz of America products do not intentionally contain any hazardous substances in Proposition 65. Magnet Schultz of America products do not come in contact with human skin and is not intended to be consumed in any way by humans.

There is no risk of human exposure. Therefore, Magnet Schultz of America products do not require California Proposition 65 warning labeling.

The regulated Toxic Substances Control Act Section 6(h) Persistent, Bioaccumulate, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals are listed below:

- decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

Magnet Schultz of America products do not intentionally contain any of the Section 6(h) chemicals and based on our review, Magnet Schultz of America manufacturing processes do not use any chemicals that are prohibited by the new Section 6(h) regulations.
